## Safety Reminders

Parents: Drivers may not use cell phones while driving on campus, or through school zones.

Thank you for your patience with the traffic congestion before and after school. Some bus routes were eliminated last year, therefore; we have more automobile, bike and pedestrian traffic. Please be cautious while driving.

Please remind your children of the importance of taking precautions to safeguard their personal safety.

- Do not play on the school playground after school without parent, or adult supervision. Adults should always bring a cell phone to the playground in case of emergencies.
- Don't engage in conversations, or go anywhere with strangers.
- Do not play in isolated places, or go into the wooded areas without parent or adult supervision.
- Always wear a helmet when riding a bike.
- Cross only at cross walks, or intersections and look both ways before crossing streets.
- Walk, don't run into the cross walks and intersections.
- Do not enter the streets from between parked cars, in the middle of the block, or from behind shrubbery.
- Don't open doors at home to strangers, or tell callers that parents are not home.
- Children should walk or bike to and from their destinations with friend or family member whenever possible.
- Children may have fun using "walkie talkies" to communicate with their parents when they are playing in their neighborhood, or walking/ biking to and from school.
