

REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES

- **Please bring the original documents** listed below in order to complete kindergarten registration:
(We will make copies of your documents and return the originals before you leave.)

Proof of residence (mortgage, house title, lease or current RRISD Tax Statement)

Original birth certificate, passport, or a signed hospital certificate.
Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age on, or before Sept. 1, 2009.

Immunization record from physician, clinic or previous school
Please watch for postings and check with your physician regarding changes in immunization requirements before the beginning of school. Proof of immunizations must be received before the first day of school.

First Grade – Sixth Grade

5 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, Td, Tdap with one on/after 4th birthday **OR** 4 doses if one dose is on/after the 4th birthday
4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4th birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4th birthday
2 doses of Measles, 1 dose Mumps and 1 dose Rubella on/after 1st birthday
3 doses of Hepatitis B
1 dose of Varicella on/after 1st birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)
✓ Ages 7 years and older, 3 doses of DTP containing vaccine.

Kindergarten

5 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT with one on/after 4th birthday **OR** 4 doses if one dose is on/after the 4th birthday
4 doses of °Polio with one on/after 4th birthday **OR** 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4th birthday
2 doses of MMR on/after 1st birthday
3 doses of Hepatitis B
2 doses of Varicella on/after 1st birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)
2 doses of Hepatitis A on/after 1st birthday (must allow 18 months between doses)

3 year olds and 4 year olds (PRE K)

4 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT
3 doses of Polio
1 dose of MMR on/after 1st birthday
1 dose of HIB on/after 15 months **OR** 3 doses with the 3rd dose given on/after 1st birthday, and at least 2 months since dose #2
1 dose of *PCV7 on/or after 24 months of age **OR** 4 doses of PCV7 with one given after 1st birthday
3 doses of Hepatitis B
1 dose of Varicella on/after 1st birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)
2 doses of Hepatitis A on/after 1st birthday (must allow 18 months between doses)
⊕ HIB and PCV7 not routinely administered to children ≥ 5 years of age.

* DTP/ DTaP /DT/Td and Polio series must include a dose on or after the 4th birthday to be complete

Serologic confirmation of immunity or evidence of infection from measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B or varicella is accepted in lieu of vaccine. History and written documentation of Chicken Pox disease is acceptable and required.

Student's Social Security number is requested (please bring the card)
P.I.E.M.S. number if your child has been enrolled in another Texas public school kindergarten or pre-k.

Requests for Alternative Placement must be submitted in writing to the principal by the end of the 2008-2009 school year (for kindergarten students registering during spring Kindergarten Round-Up), or within two weeks of enrollment (for student's who enroll during the 2009-2010 school year).

Language Proficiency Testing will be coordinated by Ms. Camilla Bolch (464-4304) for new students who speak a language other than English in their home. Testing will be available during kindergarten registration, or at a later date by appointment.

Additional Information Requested for Enrollment: Doctors' telephone numbers, emergency contact names and telephone numbers, parents' work numbers, cell phone numbers, e-mail addresses and pager numbers will be needed to complete registration.
