TUTORING

Teacher Tutorials:

- Individual teachers offer tutoring before/ after school:
dates and times are available through individual teachers for students
also made available to parents/students through syllabus and teacher websites

Departmental Tutorials:

- Scheduled by the individual department to be offered before/ after school.

Library Nights:

- Wednesday and Thursday nights in the Library from 4:30-7:00 P.M. for MATH and SCIENCE. Late Bus available ONLY on Wednesday night and students MUST have a pass from the Library to ride the bus which leaves at 5:30 P.M. Students MUST bring their work or be productive on the computer lab. The late bus may also be used by students receiving tutorials in other content areas. Passes will be provided by teachers to ride the bus.

Saturday Tutorials:

- Assistance for MATH and SCIENCE offered most Saturdays throughout the year from 9 A.M. -12 Noon. Students meet in the cafeteria and then disperse to the teachers' classroom. Assistance for MATH and SCIENCE.

Learning Lab:

- A staffed classroom that is available every period to students who need assistance (homework and/ or testing).
- Location is Room # C108
- Lab is opened before school 8:15- 9:55 A.M. and after school 4:05 P.M. until 4:30 P.M. and during the day (with a pass from their teacher) if the student needs to take a test or assistance is needed on their assignments.

Library: Opened daily from 8:15 A.M. – 4:30 P.M.

Library Nights – Wednesday and Thursday until 7:00 P.M.

Parent/ Teacher Conference

- Can be scheduled with teachers for a one on one conference that they set up with the parent, OR
- The counselor or parent may request a conference with the student, parent, and all teachers
