

Students took the 8th Grade Math Benchmark recently. This assessment, made by the district, was designed to assess students' ability to answer questions related to the curriculum taught during the first 12 weeks of school and the most frequently missed questions in RRISD on previous 8th grade TAKS tests. In other words, it was an extra hard TAKS test. Your teachers will be posting your child's grade on the HAC, but remember, it does not count towards their six weeks average.

Average Student Score for CTMS . . . 72% Passing Standard . . . 60%
Commended Standard . . . 90%

Since the math test incorporated many of the hardest questions from past TAKS tests, any students scoring above 50% is probably on track to pass their 8th grade TAKS tests.
