Discipline Guidelines

First Level Infractions

1. All students are expected to follow the Cougar Expectations and Student Code of Conduct.
2. **Minor** classroom disruptions are handled by staff members; staff members may impose a variety of consequences for repeat offenses.
3. Detention halls will be assigned after school or during lunch.
4. Parents will receive notification of after school detention hall assignments at least one day prior.
5. Students with more than three detention dates scheduled, at one time, will be required to serve this time during Saturday Detention or I.S.S. as scheduled by the appropriate Grade Level Assistant Principal.

Second Level Infractions

1. Behavior which warrants a discipline referral or immediate removal from the classroom will be addressed by an administrator. Please refer to the Student Code of Conduct for a list of behaviors which fall under this category.
2. Students with repeat offenses will receive appropriate consequences as aligned with the offense.

Profanity

1st Offense

Half-day Saturday Detention (D-Hall)

2nd Offense

Full day Saturday D-Hall

3rd Offense

Citation by School Resource Officer (S.R.O.)

NOTE: Use of profanity directed towards a staff member will result in I.S.S. or Suspension. A citation by the S.R.O. is also potentially warranted in these cases.

Cheating

Daily Grades

All Offenses – Zero (0) on the assignment. The zero (0) cannot be dropped. Parent contacted by the teacher. At teacher's discretion, an assignment can be made up.

Major Grades

Retest during the assigned Saturday D-Hall.

For other major grades (i.e., projects, etc.) an alternate assignment will be given. This will be submitted during the assigned Saturday D- Hall.

Parent contacted by an administrator.

Failure to Comply with Consequence

Missed Lunch D-Hall

In School Suspension (I.S.S.) plus reassigned D-Hall

Missed Saturday

ISS plus reassigned Saturday detention.

Aggressive Behavior and/or Fighting

1st Offense

Possible suspension & ISS

2nd Offense

Possible assignment to the Round Rock Opportunity Center (RROC) and Citation by S.R.O.

Misbehavior with a Substitute

Regular teacher will determine the severity. Lunch detention or discipline referral to an administrator may result.

Tobacco Use or Possession

1st Offense

I.S.S. or suspension & Citation by S.R.O.

2nd Offense

Suspension & Citation by S.R.O. and possible assignment to R.R.O.C.

Tardies

Excessive tardies will result in disciplinary action.
